It was announced that a new free online practical training programme developed by the European-wide partnership between Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Poland, Spain is available for startups, small businesses and entrepreneurs. The programme provides

companies with training modules across core six business areas that are recognised as being essential for developing and growing a successful business: financial and economic literacy, leadership and initiative, intellectual property rights, project management and planning, creativity, and cooperation and team-working. The online Eurostart course was funded by the European

Once the course has been completed, participants receive a Europass Certificate – a credential recognised throughout the EU.
